

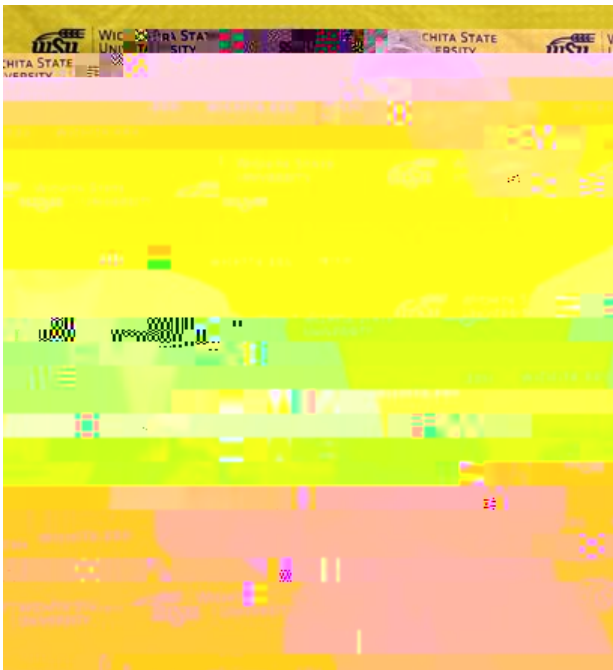
The 2019 third quarterly EDO meeting for the Greater Wichita Partnership was held at WSU Haysville in August, '19.

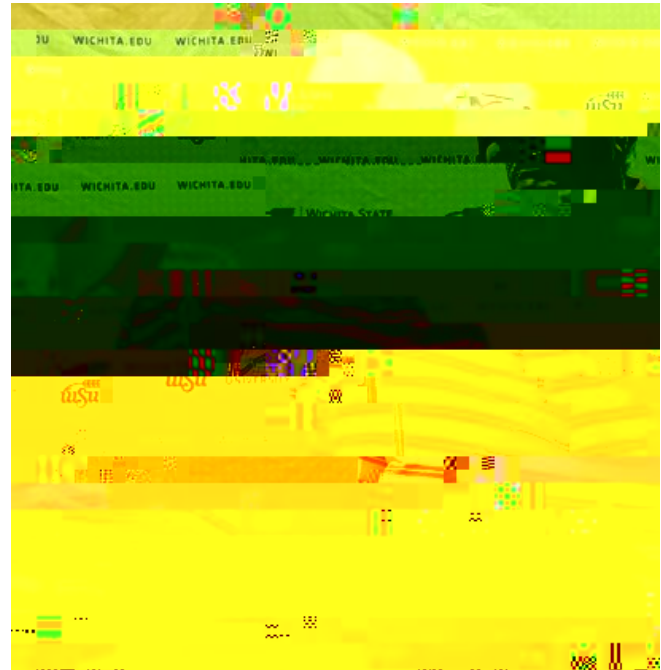
