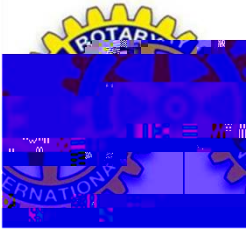

Kansas Council for Economic Education receives grant from Rotary District 5690 through the Rotary Foundation and the Wichita Rotary Charitable Fund



The Rotary District 5690 through the Rotary Foundation and the Wichita Rotary Charitable Fund have funded \$4000 for economic literacy through participation in the Stock Market Game for the Wichita Area.

Each year, in Kansas, more than 15,000 students across Kansas participate in the interactive Stock Market Game. The Stock Market Game is an investing simulation which incorporates math, personal finance & critical thinking skills. Lessons are correlated with state & national standards and can be integrated into almost any subject area.

In the Wichita Metro Area, more than 2,000 students participate.

This grant will fund the fees associated with students and teachers in the Wichita Metro Area who participate in the Stock Market Game.
