PROGRAM GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

GOAL #1: STUDENTS WILL LEARN A BROAD RANGE OF GEOLOGIC KNOWLEDGE AND THE ABILITY TO APPLY IT ON AN INTEGRATED BASIS.

Assessment of Goal #2: The undergraduate curriculum will be reviewed on a rotating 3 year basis using recommended standards of the American Geological Institute, the American Association of Petroleum Geologists and a subgroup of the WSU GeoAdvisory organization. Results of students post graduate success in taking the exams for state licensing of geologists will be tracked.

Assessment of Goal #3: Students may demonstrate success in meeting this goal by involvement in one or more of the following activities and external recognition -

- 1. Professional oral presentations
- 2. Professional pulication
- 3. External and/or internal grants
- 4. Awards from Professional Societies, etc.
- 5. Presentation at local, regional and national conferences.

Each of these measures is notable and represents mastery of the geosciences.
