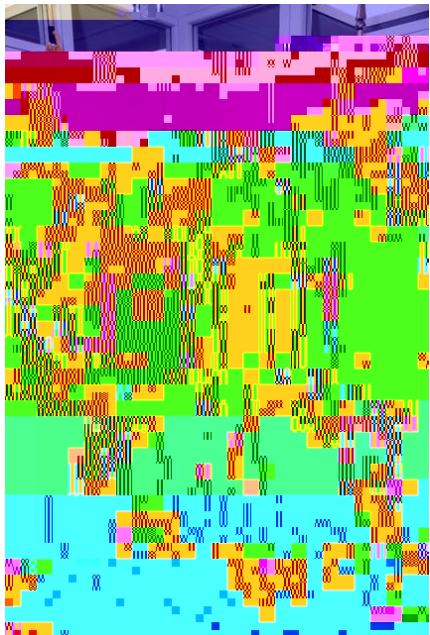

DC INTERNSHIPS

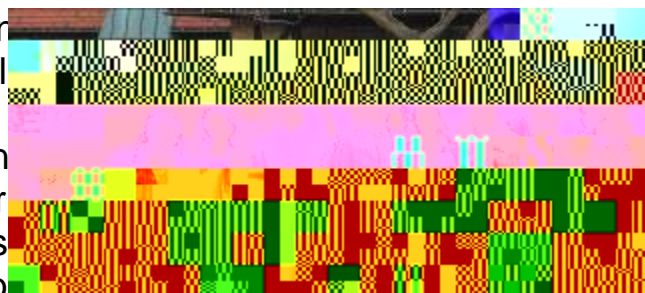

The interns participate in a weekly seminar with guest speakers and weekly briefings on current political events. This year they got to spend an evening with former Governor Parkinson and his wife Sarah Binder from the Brookings Institute, and Tim Zimmerman from Georgetown University Law Center among other visits around the city. MODEL UN IN ST. LOUIS & NEW YORK

Wichita State Model UN students conducted extensive research into the foreign policy of Switzerland and United Kingdom last year in preparation for the Midwest Model UN conference in St. Louis. In February they spent four days negotiating with students from across the country on global issues ranging from the weaponization of space and peacekeeper accountability, to food sovereignty and the repatriation of refugees. 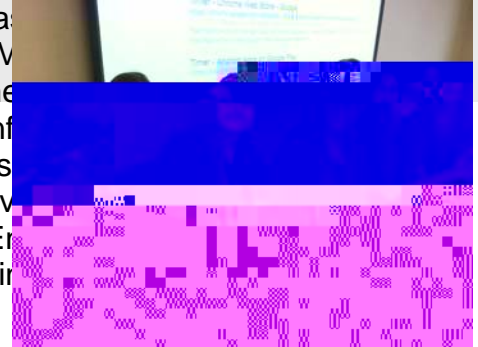
