- Figures are estimates given by Host University. Figures were given in host currency and converted to United States Dollars using a floating exchange rate.
As of 08/07/2024, 1 Euro (EUR) = 1.09 (USD)
- Hamburg Semester Contribution of 295 Euros must be paid by all students and includes a semester ticket which allows you unlimited travel on Hamburg's public transport system for the whole semester. We also added an estimated \$109 bank transfer fee.
- Accommodation can range from 320-450 Euros per month.
- Meals on average at university cafeterias are 3.73 Euros. For 3 meals a day for 150 days (5 months) it is approximately 1,475 Euros.
- No exact estimate was provided by the partner university, however we estimate that you should not spend over \$150 for textbooks for one semester.
- The GeoBlue Student Insurance Plan is required for international travel. The total cost is based on the total number of days the student is abroad. As of July 2024, it cost \$1.46 per day for a maximum \$100,000 coverage and \$100 deductible. 150 days (5 months) will be approximately \$219. There are different coverage plans available at different prices.
- It is required to get German Health Insurance for students while in Germany. This costs up to 130 Euros per month.
- Residence permit and alien registration are required for all non-EU students.
