

What is an ATIA?

An **Active Threat Incident** is an incident in which an individual who is causing or threatening to cause death and/or serious bodily injury. This isn't exclusive to somebody with a firearm. This could be accomplished with a knife or a bat or with personal items that are used as weapons.

An event is unpredictable and can be deadly. Knowing what to do can save lives.

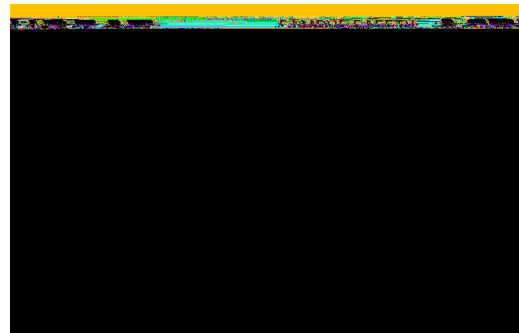
ACTIVE THREAT INCIDENT PLANNING

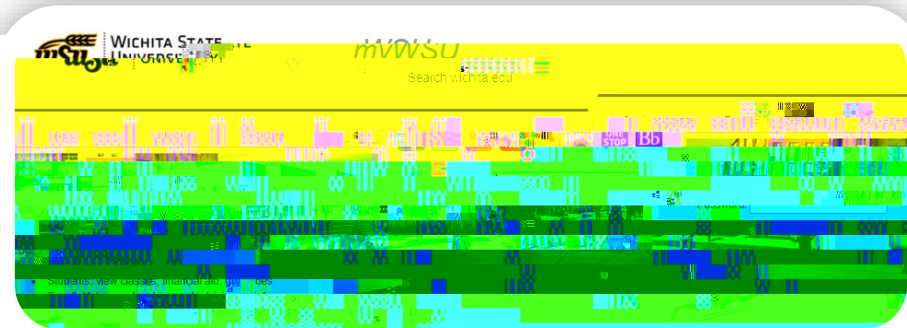

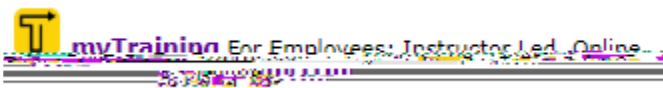

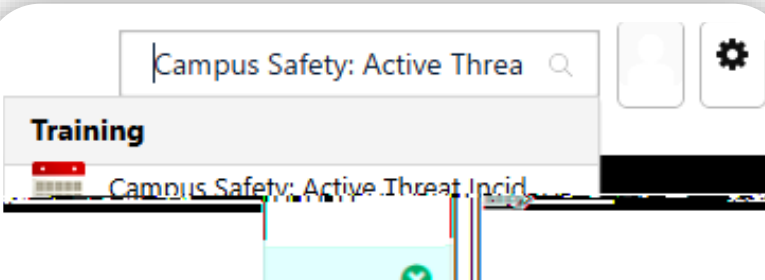
